

# Lost Lake News

A lot is happening on Lost Lake.

At the Lost Lake District's September 2018 annual meeting, lake property owners voted to approve the annual district budget of \$66,970 which included funding for another year of herbicide treatment of the invasive aquatic plant Curly Leaf Pondweed (CLP).

The district was also just awarded a state grant of \$71,000 for the continued treatment of the CLP in our lake. This grant will take over when our current Early Detection grant for CLP expires this June.

Lost Lake will again be involved with CBCW boat inspections at our public landing using volunteers as well as UW Oshkosh interns.

In other news, the Lost Lake Community Club and the Lake District joined forces in an effort to stock more walleye in the lake this coming fall; the LLCC directors approved \$1,500 and the LLPRD pledged \$3,500 to be spent on 2,500 extended growth walleye.

Finally, we promote summer social activities by holding weekly pontoon and dinner get-togethers, an annual golf/dinner outing, and Tues/Thur softball games at Vandervort Park.

As I said, a lot is going on at Lost Lake.
