Fun Facts

We thought we would share a few facts about our Club and its operations.

- With over 100 miles of trails, St Germain is known for having the best trail system in the State .
 - We are appreciative of the more than **40 kind landowners** who allow us to maintain winter trails across their properties
 - Volunteers and our crew of 16 dedicated and experienced groomer operators logged over nearly 310 hours doing trail & equipment work and another ~1310 hours grooming trails
 - There are more than **1,000 Trail and Route signs** used to mark the trails. These signs provide direction, warnings, and information to riders
 - Over 6500 miles of trails were groomed this past winter season covering 5 routes on 65 nights
 - The Bo-Boen's print over 5,000 annual Trail Maps which includes advertising and location details for 98 map sponsors. Maps are distributed to members, establishments throughout the area, and the Chamber of Commerce.
- The Club operates 3 Groomers with Drags:
 - o 2024 Tucker Terra purchased 7/2023 9'6" Arrowhead drag
 - 2023 Tucker Terra
- 8'6" Arrowhead drag
- 2023 New Holland Tractor w/tracks
 9'6" Arrowhead drag
- o Arrowhead drags are manufactured locally in St Germain
- ~\$850,000 investment in grooming equipment. The equipment is housed in a locally built and maintained Groomer Barn
- Membership was slightly up this past season to 1200+ making the Club the **largest in the State**
 - This was helped by our expanding reach with our Facebook page (up 2k followers to over 11k)
- Annually, Bo-Boen DNR Certified Snowmobile Safety Instructors host the largest in-person safety class in the State. The class averages 50-75 youths often with parents participating and/or spending time in the area.
- St Germain has also been recognized as a **Snowmobile Friendly Town** by the Association of Wisconsin Snowmobile Clubs
