Please complete the form and return it to the town clerk at P.O. Box 7, St. Germain, WI 54558. When you come in to vote on election day, you will have to bring in proof of residency. You can bring in a copy of your property tax bill, electric bill, gas bill, anything that shows that you are living in the Town of St. Germain. If you don't have any of proof of residency, you can have a neighbor vouch for you. However, they will have to have some kind of proof of residency with them. That is, one form is needed for the September and/or November elections, and one form is needed for the February and/or April elections.
