## Guide for naming or renaming private roads to conform to the Town of St. Germain Ordinance

<u>AVENUE</u>: A wide principle thoroughfare often bordered by trees. Avenues will be designated, as much as possible, for predominantly east/west thoroughfares. *Abbreviation* – AVE.

<u>CIRCLE</u>: A thoroughfare that returns to the same origin point or to the same originating road. *Abbreviation* – CIR.

<u>COURT</u>: A thoroughfare that ends in a cul-de-sac or dead end that has no potential for extension with additional property subdivision. Courts will be designated as much as possible for predominantly north/south roads. *Abbreviation* – CT.

<u>DRIVE</u>: A street that is accessible from its origin to terminus that winds in a predominantly north/south direction. Abbreviation – DR.

<u>LANE</u>: A thoroughfare that ends in a cul-de-sac or dead end that has no potential for extension with additional property subdivision. Lanes will be designated, as much as possible, for predominantly east/west roads. *Abbreviation* – LN.

<u>PLACE</u>: A minor thoroughfare that is accessible from both its origin and terminus. Places will predominately, as much as possible, travel north/south. *Abbreviation* – PL.

<u>ROAD</u>: A major thoroughfare that is accessible from both its origin and terminus. Roads predominantly, as much as possible, travel east/west. Abbreviation - RD.

<u>STREET</u>: A major thoroughfare that is accessible from both its origin and terminus. Streets predominately, as much as possible, travel north/south. *Abbreviation* – ST.

<u>TRAIL</u>: A minor thoroughfare that is accessible from both its origin and terminus. Trails predominately, as much as possible, travel east/west. *Abbreviation* – TRL.

<u>WAY</u>: A minor thoroughfare that is accessible from both its origin and terminus. Ways predominately, as much as possible, travel north/south. Abbreviation – WY.
