1. Call to order: Ritter called meeting to order at 10:02am

## 4. Discussion/action topics:

- **a. Approve minutes of July 13, 2021, meeting:** Motion Rollman, second Steinhilber to approve as presented. Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.
- b. Review draft five-year boat patrol plan: Ritter shared what he had learned about the Manitowish Waters grant funded boat patrol program and provided an updated five-year projected budget. All lake organizations reported support for moving ahead, pending elector approvals at the upcoming four annual lake district meetings. The Committee will meet again in September to make a final decision about the project.

- **c. Update Waisbrot, town fishery management plan:** Waisbrot's group continues to meet and exchange messages with DNR Fisheries Biologist Erik Wegneitner. No specific management plan details to share at this point.
- **d.** Committee concerns for future meeting agendas: Ritter intends for all future agendas to include a review of committee finances and approval of lake improvement funds spending requests.
- e. Set date and time for next meeting: Monday, September 13, 10:00am
- **5. Adjourn:** There being no other business to conduct, Ritter declared the meeting adjourned at 11:10.
