Meeting minutes, 08/17/2023

- 1. Call to order: Meeting called to order by Ritter at 10:00AM
- 2. Confirm meeting posting: Agenda was posted on 10/10/2023 in accordance with Town Board procedures
- 3. Verify a quorum in attendance: Meeting was conducted by Chairman Ted Ritter in Room 4 of the St. Germain Community Center with a virtual attendance option. Committee members physically present in Room 4: Joe Koschnik, Roy Seidl, Jeannie Lord, Barb Steinhilber, June Vogel, Dave Zielinski, Jim Guckenberg, Eric Eade, Bob Schell, Ed Kindlarski and Ted Ritter.
- 4. Public comments (other than agenda topics):
 - **a.** A Lake Content property owner reported that weeds there are "obnoxious", worse than ever. Wakeboat traffic is scattering chopped weeds and making a mess.
 - **b.** Attendees recognized the recent passing of both Ann Waisbrot and Mary Platner.
- 5. Discussion/action topics:
 - a. Approve minutes of July 20, 2023, meeting: Motion Steinhilber, second Lord to approve as presented. Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

- **b.** Update on wakes issues: Schell reported that WI Lakes and the Wilderness Alliance have joined forces to advance public awareness and to drive needed legislation. Statewide interest in the topic continues to grow.
- **c.** Individual lake organization updates regarding comprehensive management plans: No updates are likely until after the lake organization annual meetings.

d. Review financial reports:

- 1. Individual lake balances: Reviewed and understood.
- 2. Committee account balance: Reviewed and understood.

e. Approve lakes improvement spending requests:

- 1. Motion Schell, second Steinhilber to approve Lost Lake's request to spend \$939.00 of 2023 operations funds to replace buoy markers. Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.
- 2. Motion Seidel, second Steinhilber to approve Big St. Germain's request to spend \$1,281.00 of 2023 operations funds to help cover expenses associated with creating a legal description for the land surrounding the Lake Content dam. Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.
- 3. Motion Eade, second Guckenberg to approve Found Lake's request to spend \$883.00 of 2023 operations funds to help cover expenses associated with analyzing boat landing CBCW camera data. Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.
- f. Reconsider how the annual allotment of room tax revenues from the Town Board to the Lakes Committee can be used: Schell wondered if the Town Treasurer is able to determine what percentage of annual room tax revenues are generated by waterfront lodging establishments vs non-waterfront businesses such as motels. Ritter agreed to ask the Treasurer if that is possible.
- g. Update from the Fisheries Management Team: None
- **h.** Facebook page update: Eade reported he continues to update the page with fresh information. Interest in the page remains constant.
- **i.** Committee concerns for future agenda: Lord was requested to gather information about creating boat decals to carry the same message as the key tags.
- 6. Adjourn: Meeting adjourned by Ritter at 11:54. Next meeting 10:00AM, Thursday, September 21, 2023
