## MINUTES SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING: JANUARY 5, 2009

- **1.** Call To Order: The chairman noted that this was a duly called meeting in accordance with the Wisconsin Open Meeting Law. The meeting was called to order at 5:00 P.M.
- **2. Roll Call:** Peggy Nimz, Todd Wiese, Fred Radtke, John Vojta, Lee Christensen, Tom Martens, town clerk. Boyd Best was also in attendance.
- **3. Approval of Agenda:** Motion Wiese seconded Vojta that the agenda be approved in any order at the discretion of the chairman. Approved.
- 4. Items for Consideration (Approve, Disapprove, Table):
  - 4.1 Motion to Convene into Closed Session. It is anticipated a motion will made and seconded to convene into closed session pursuant to Sec. 19.85(1)(e) for the purpose to discuss employee contracts: Motion Christensen seconded Wiese that the meeting be convened into closed session at 5:01 P.M. Approved. Boyd Best remained at the meeting.
  - **4.2 Motion to Reconvene into Open Session:** Motion Christensen seconded Vojta that the meeting be reconvened into open session at 6:18 P.M. Approved.
  - **4.3 Action on Closed Session, If Necessary:** Motion Wiese seconded Christensen that Mr. Vojta talk to the golf course employees and the public employees to try to get the contracts signed and that Mr. Vojta talk with Mr. Stippich concerning his insurance and that the contracts will remain as they are with the word "drunkenness" to be removed from the last sentence of Article 14 of Mr. Ebert's and Mr. VanMeter's contracts and with the sentence, "This position requires a valid CDL license", to be added. ## 6. Board Concerns:

**Fred Radtke:** Mr. Radtke asked if when Mr. VanMeter gets married, will his insurance stipend go up to be comparable to the other married employees.

**Ms. Nimz:** Ms. Nimz asked for items for the January 12, 2009 agenda. Ms. Nimz also stated that she had received complaints about the new name of a private easement road owned by Doug Knapp. It is the consensus of the board that since Mr. Knapp owns the road, the people who have the easement have nothing to say about how the road is named.

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**Mr. Christensen:** Mr. Christensen asked the status of the setback problem at Serenity Bay on Halberstadt Road. Mr. Wiese stated that Darren Rubo had not met with Mr. Ebert. He thought that the estimate to move the road was around \$18,000. Cornerstone Builders will be paying to move the road.
