- <u>Action of Permits and Plan Submittals:</u> Mr. Ebert showed the committee the Julius Schehl property via computer. He found nothing wrong with the application that was submitted at the last meeting. It was approved at that time conditionally to Mr. Ebert's approval.

Charlie Vogel Travelway Permit at 7647 Birchwood Drive. Mr. Ebert advised that they needed to correct the distance of the pipes on the application and he would be fine. They are replacing an existing driveway with a new one. Mr. Vogel couldn't get an easement across Helmuth's property so he will put a new one in so he can sell the property without complications. A motion was made by Mr. Santefort subject to Mr. Ebert going out there to make sure they move the pipe five feet from the edge of the current lot line. Mr. Odette seconded this motion. Motion unanimously carried.

Kelly and Cory Newton would like to put a fence up on their property on Sunset Blvd. However, there is an argument between them and the neighbors regarding the property line. They were advised that they do not need a permit from the Town to put the six foot wood privacy fence up but would need one from the County. With regards to the property line, it was suggested that they should get a survey done. It was stated that we have no jurisdiction on this and this was brought to the committee for informational purposes only.
