- 4. Action Items (Approve, Disapprove, Table)
 - A. Rogacki Conditional Use Permit for Detached Garage on Big St. Germain Lake: Motion Platner seconded Ritter to approve a Conditional Use Permit for Mr. & Mrs. Mark Rogacki for their proposed detached garage as laid out in their sketch with the condition that the building is located as presented and that the materials are as presented by the applicant. Approved. Mr. Joost cited the six standards for granting a conditional use permit as stated in Section 1.70(4) of the St. Germain Zoning Ordinance. Mr. Joost stated that the Rogackis had met all six of the standards.
- 5. Citizen Concerns: There were no citizen concerns.
- 6. **Committee Concerns:** Mr. Joost stated that he felt that the conditional use permit that the Rogackis had received last year should have been a variance. Mr. Joost stated that the St. Germain Zoning Ordinance states that there are to be 150 feet of frontage for each residential structure on a property. There is a density problem with the Rogacki property.
