RESOLUTION 1/3/05-02-0 RELATING TO SMOKE FREE TOWN BUILDINGS AND MOTOR VEHICLES

WHEREAS, the town of Saint Germain is committed to providing a healthy and safe environment for its employees and the public; and

WHEREAS, the United States Surgeon General declared in a 1986 report on involuntary smoking that:

- Involuntary smoking is a cause of disease, including lung cancer, in healthy non-smokers
- The simple separation of smokers and non-smokers within the same air space may reduce, but does not eliminate, the exposure of nonsmokers to environmental tobacco smoke

and

WHEREAS, the Vilas County Public Health Department is encouraging all Vilas County town boards to adopt a smoke fee policy for public buildings and vehicles,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of Supervisors of the town of Saint Germain, that smoking of tobacco products shall be prohibited by all persons in all town owned buildings and vehicles including:

- Offices
- o Hallways
- Waiting rooms
- o Restrooms
- Lunch rooms
- Meeting rooms
- Community work areas
