Re: Proposed Aquatic Herbicide Application for Exotic Invasive Species control on Lost Lake.

Dear Lost Lake Property Owner or Occupant:

The Lost Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District (the District) proposes to assess and chemically approximately 30 acres on Lost Lake to control the excessive growth of the exotic invasive aquatic plant, Curlyleaf pondweed (CLP) in accordance with their approved Lake Management Plan. The District proposes to conduct an application of Aquathol K (liquid endothal) targeting the CLP and anticipate this proposed treatment to occur sometime in spring, 2020 and will proceed only after the District obtains a permit for the treatment from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.

Notification of the exact dates of treatment and water use restrictions associated with the use of Aquathol K will be provided by the posting of shoreline in and adjacent to treatment areas, and public access points.

The water use restrictions associated with use of the above Aquathol K are noted below:

There are no water use restrictions with the proposed use of Aquathol K on Lost Lake.
