Meeting Minutes, February 15, 2022

1. **Call to Order** –Mortag called the meeting to order at 5:32 PM
2. **Roll Call establish a quorum:** Mortag conducted the meeting in the St. Germain Chamber of Commerce Board Room. Committee members in attendance, Strom, Anderson, Koziatek, Gebhardt & Mortag

  - a. **Fright Night at the Park update:** Fright night was a success. We raised approximately \$1500 from the event. There was a lot of positive public feedback. We will continue to do the event. The Lions will be donating all their props for the next year.
  - b. **Veterans memorial updates:** Mortag shared with the group that two new signage areas (posts) had been put up for events in town. The community is to use these areas for signage and not place signs by the memorial. Lions club in conjunction with the town is looking into new walkways. There was concern about the snowmobiles running across the memorial area.
  - c. **Budget Updates P&R:** Mortag shared that we were given a budget from the town of \$20,00 to use for Parks & Recreation.
  - d. **Quotes on Mulch.** Koziatek will get pricing for the mulch. Koziatek and Strom investigated rubber mulch and pads for playground areas. It was advised to not do this at the playground due to cost and move forward with replacing with mulch.
  - e. **Playground update.** The new equipment was ordered in November. Kalisa to follow up with June Vogel on ship date.
  - f. **Amenity suggestions:** Mortag shared possible amenity suggestions from the community. For dog parks, archery ranges, disk golf. No action taken on these items at this time.
  - g. **Vandervort Park:** The pavilion at that park is a hazard. Something needs to be done. Mortag to discuss with the town board and ask what should be done. Does it need to be replaced, fixed, tore down?
  - h. **Fundraising:** Discussed future fundraising ideas.
