ADOPTING THE ST. GERMAIN
YEAR 2020 COMPREHENSIVE LAND USE PLAN

WHEREAS, the Town Planning and Zoning Committee has conducted surveys of residents and landowners of the Town, held informational meetings and conducted public hearings to assist in the development of a comprehensive land use plan to guide future development within the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Committee, in consultation with Foth & Van Dyke, has developed a comprehensive land use plan for the Town which aims to maintain and enhance the Town of St. Germain's rural northwoods character, balancing housing needs and economic growth opportunity with integrity of the area's natural resources and which is known as the St. Germain Year 2020 Comprehensive Land Use Plan; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting on September 9, 1999, the Committee formally adopted the St. Germain Year 2020 Comprehensive Land Use Plan and recommended that the St. Germain Town Board approve and adopt the plan; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board the vision, goals and purposes of the of St. Germain Year 2020 Comprehensive Land Use Plan as a guide to the future development and use of the lands and waters of the Town.

NOW THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of St. Germain does hereby adopt the St. Germain Year 2020 Comprehensive Land Use Plan prepared by Foth & Van Dyke and dated October 11, 1999 and;
